OBTAINING A BUILDING PERMIT in ALBERTA

1. New Home Buyers Protection Office DOCUMENT (NHBPO)

Builder must obtain the "New Home Registration Form" directly from NHBPS prior to submitting a housing registration to Travelers Insurance Company of Canada.

<u>Forms:</u> Effective February 1, 2014, NBHPS will be administering the delivery of all New Home Registration Forms in conjunction with the collection of the \$95.00 per dwelling unit Registration fee.


